FACES PROGRAM REGISTRATION BULLETIN

The registration process for our College in High School Dual enrollment **FACES PROGRAM** has now begun. Enclosed find official registration forms for courses from Seton Hill University, Saint Vincent College, and Mount Aloysius College.

Use the FACES brochure provided to select the courses that you desire for college credit. It is possible to take courses from all three of these institutions. To do so, complete the necessary registration forms from each school. If you are registering for multiple courses from one institution list those courses on one registration form.

If your daughter/son is planning to attend Seton Hill University, they must complete **24 SHU** college in high school credits with the approved QPA to be eligible for the SHU scholarships.

Prior to **Friday, December 4 2009**, have your daughter/son return the completed registration form to the junior/senior guidance counselor, Mr. Brooke Seward before first period. He will review all applications to ensure that they are completed correctly. Also, if you are paying by credit card, please return your registration form(s) in a sealed envelope.

*We do not have an equivalent course for Advanced Art (this course may be able to transfer as a general Fine Arts elective). Both the Chemistry and Biology Departments have reviewed the syllabi and are working on recommendations to allow those courses to be more equivalent to our General Chemistry and General Biology courses. Both the History and English Departments have also requested more time to study the courses for possible inclusion in Fall 2009. Our Accounting faculty are still reviewing the textbook for Accounting I and II and expect a decision shortly.

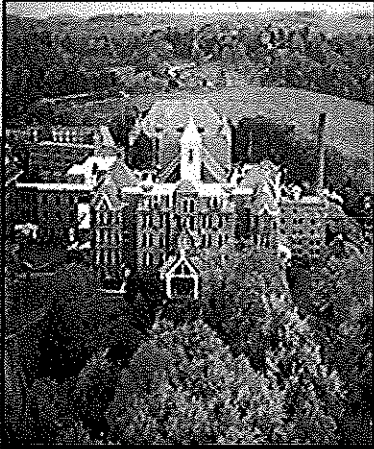

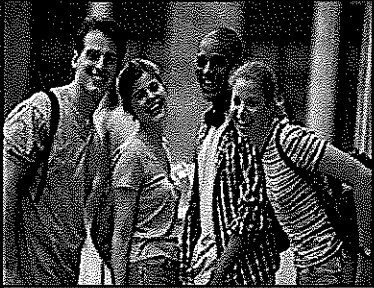
