Do you want to earn money toward your child's tuition?

HOW RaiseRight (SCRIP) WORKS – PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The RaiseRight program is a great way to earn **\$\$\$** toward your child's <u>own</u> tuition account at GCC. You purchase gift cards at face value, and the vendor gives a "rebate" off of the face value, which then becomes credit toward your child's tuition.

For example: Giant Eagle sells a \$100 card to GCC at a 4% "rebate" (ie, \$96 with \$4 as "rebate"). You receive 90% of the rebate as tuition credit (90 % x\$4 = \$3.60) with the remaining 10% kept by GCC as an administrative fee for the program.

Visit <u>www.raiseright.com</u> to view the entire list of stores, the card denominations, and the % "rebate" the vendor offers. They are all different. For instance, Bath and Body Works gives a generous 12% rebate. Eat n Park is 9%. *Remember you will receive 90% of the rebate shown for each vendor.* Click on shop, then "all categories" to view a complete list of available gift card/certificates.

Most cards are the "traditional" plastic gift cards, however, there are also many stores/businesses who allow you to re-load a card that you have previously purchased-- no need to wait, re-load right on the website. In addition, some vendors also allow you to print e-certificates to use in the store 30 minutes after ordering" YOU MUST BE SIGNED UP AND VERIFIED TO USE "PRESTO PAY" (DEDUCTION FROM CHECKING ACCOUNT) TO RE-LOAD AND PURCHASE "e-cards."

We have many parents participating and earning lots of \$\$\$ toward tuition. Anything you purchase this year (2023-2024) goes toward the following year's tuition (2024-2025); however, seniors may earn tuition credit through March of their senior year. The credit year starts new each June.

<u>All purchases are made on the RaiseRight website – we do not keep an inventory of cards on hand to sell at GCC.</u> You must set up an account to purchase RaiseRight. Please see the following pages for information about how to set up your account, pay for your order, and pick up your cards.
