If your child is currently enrolled in a CHS class or class that offers CHS credits, you can purchase college credits through Seton Hill University, Saint Vincent College, Saint Francis University, or Mount Aloysius College. Registration info guides for each college are on our website. Each College/University has a different deadline and pricing. These are noted in the brochure and registration guides.

Saint Vincent College is currently updating their CHS registration platform. Information will be shared with your student(s) as soon as it is made available.

Please see the information below if you have questions regarding the difference between CHS and AP.

CHS vs AP

CHS means, College in High School.

CHS is different than AP.

However, some of our AP classes can also earn CHS credits with our partner colleges/universities.

AP is governed by CollegeBoard. They determine the curriculum and teachers who want to teach an AP class agree to teach that curriculum. CollegeBoard also has an AP exam at the end of the school year for each AP class. At GCC if you take an AP class you must take the AP exam.

CHS is a partnership with Saint Vincent College, Seton Hill University, Saint Francis University, and Mount Aloysius College. These colleges have looked at several of our classes and curriculum and determined the work and content is equal to a class that is taught on their campus. In the fall, I will visit all CHS classes and give students information to purchase college credits from one of these schools. When you graduate from GCC, if you purchase the credits from one of these schools, you'll have a college transcript that says you completed the class and earned college credit. GCC also offers two CHS classes through the University of Pittsburgh (CHS Pitt Calculus and CHS Pitt Physics) and the teachers of those classes will share registration information in the fall.
