## PIAA sports physicals

PIAA sports physicals will be held <u>on June 7<sup>th</sup> 9 am-11 am</u>. Students planning to receive a physical on June 7th must have a completed packet signed by both the student and parent/guardian. Physicians cannot complete a physical if the packets are not filled out and signed. If students are receiving physicals from their primary care physician or at an urgent care, physicals

must be the PIAA form and <u>completed after June 1</u>st.
