First Day of School Reminders

- Students should arrive by 7:30 am and must be in their homeroom by 7:35 am. Students who arrive at 7:35 am or later, must enter through the main entrance and report to the main office. Students who arrive at 7:35 or later will be marked tardy and must have a written excuse. Student drivers who consistently arrive late may lose their parking privileges.
- Car Rider drop-off before school is at the cafeteria courtyard or school main entrance by 7:30 am. After 7:30 am, all students must enter through the school main entrance.
- Student drivers must park in the yellow parking spaces ONLY. You must have a parking pass to park in the GCC parking lot.
- All students must be in formal uniform on the first day of school for picture day. The photos are used for the GCC Id Badges.
- Cell phones will be collected in every class. Cell phones and earbuds are only permitted in the hallways and during lunch. Cell phones and watches will be collected during assessments.
