Student Lunch Accounts

All lunch accounts need to be kept current. If your child owes a balance, please take care of the balance as soon as possible. Students who have a negative balance are not permitted to buy extras or a la carte items.

Morning Arrival Reminders

- Students should arrive by 7:30 am and must be in their homeroom by 7:35 am. Students who arrive at 7:35 am or later, must enter through the main entrance (the doorbell has been moved back to the main entrance) and report to the main office. Students who arrive at 7:35 or later will be marked tardy and must have a written excuse. Student drivers who consistently arrive late may lose their parking privileges.
- Car Rider drop-off before school is at the cafeteria courtyard or school main entrance by 7:30 am. After 7:30 am, all students must enter through the main entrance.
- Student drivers must park in the yellow parking spaces ONLY. You must have a 2024-2025 parking pass to park in the GCC parking lot.
- Cell phones will be collected in every class. Cell phones and earbuds are only permitted in the hallways and during lunch. Cell phones and watches will be collected during assessments.

Car Rider Dismissal Reminders

- Any parent or guardian that is picking up a student at dismissal, must park in a parking space in the main parking lot. Please do not pull behind the buses.
- Car riders are dismissed from the cafeteria doors and Door 16. They need to be able to walk safely to parked cars. Your attention to this is greatly appreciated.
