PSAT

Mrs. Burke and Br. Xavier visited all 9th and 10th grade students last week to share information regarding PSAT scores and CollegeBoard accounts. All students present created an account or accessed their existing CollegeBoard account and viewed their most recent PSAT scores from the October test date. Students accessed the BlueBook application on their laptops to link their scores and create practice programs. CollegeBoard's Big Future links were also shared, and students were encouraged to visit the links and complete the Career Quiz. Individual guidance meetings will be scheduled with the few students who were unable to access an existing CollegeBoard account due to password or email account issues.


